



Het Old Hickory monument staat op de plaats waar op 14 september 1944 het 2e bataljon van het 117de regiment van de XXX U.S. infanterie divisie Old Hickory de Maas overstak in het kader van de bevrijding van Maastricht.

The Old Hickory monument is located on the precise spot where, on 14 september 1944, the 2nd Battalion of the 117th Regiment of the XXXth U.S. Infantry Division, nicknamed Old Hickory, crossed the river Meuse during the liberation of Maastricht.



Monument to the 30th Infantry Division in commemoration of the Liberation of the City of Maastricht, on 14 September 1944, the first City in Holland to be liberated. Located on the east bank of the Maas River, at the point of the initial entry into Maastricht, by the 2nd Battalion of the 117th Regiment.
